Whether you choose to pop in for a pre-countdown three-course dinner or make Tongue & Cheek your main destination for a five-course meal and dancing, the Prohibition-era vibe will reign throughout the night. The party kicks off with a Krug Grande Cuvée toast, followed by dinner choices ranging from Kobe beef to poached main lobster and live jazz played through the stroke of midnight.
